Our responsibility is to review Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with guidance issued by the National Audit Office (NAO) on behalf of the Comptroller and Auditor General (see note below). Our work **does not** constitute an audit carried out in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK & Ireland) and **does not** provide the same level of assurance that such an audit would do.

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Except for the matters reported below\*, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

- The AGAR was not fully and accurately completed before submission for review. The responses given in Section 1, Box 9 and Section 2, Box 11 are incorrect and inconsistent with the prior year responses. The Council has confirmed that it does not act as sole managing trustee for trust funds and thus the answers should read 'N/A' and 'No' respectively.
- The smaller authority has not addressed the 'except for' matter raised by the external auditor when qualifying the prior year Annual Return. The 2016/17 figure in Section 2, Box 10 was not correctly restated. It should read £4,512.
