Financial Year 2020/2021

October 2020 Budget Review

Key changes to note:

- 1. Salaries budget has increased due to increase of Clerk's hours from 25 to 30 from 1/6/20, 2.75% National Pay Award (our original budget was based on 2%) and Pension deficit payments £2239.
- 2. Village Hall individual items £1200 of unexpected expenditure due to Covid 19. Budget has been increased by £1000 to allow for this.
- 3. Waste removal and utilities budget reduced due to savings during lockdown.
- 4. Play equipment checks Gym equipment on Dale Crescent that needs fixing Budget increased to reflect this.
- 5. I have stripped out bonfire, village hall events and advertising spending as I don't think there will be expenditure this financial year now.
- 6. CIL income is significantly less than NSDC had forecast. NSDC have confirmed that this was underpaid in error and will be paid in April 2021. I have requested that this is paid earlier.
- 7. Hall income forecast reduced from £29,000 (including bar profit) to £13,000. Due to Covid 19. Some regular hirers have not come back yet and the ad hoc hire is limited to business bookings.
- 8. Covid Grant received £10,000.
- 9. Suggestion increased precept assist from Parish Council to Village Hall is increased from £4000 to £6000.
